

A Very Important Pattern in English



Remember this pattern. You will need it in many Grammar topics.



[Consonant-Vowel-Consonant]

This pattern is very useful in English. When you have a word and its last 3 letters has this pattern, there are some special spelling rules. We will discover them all in the following slides.



Mono-syllable Adjectives in Comparatives



- If the adjective ends in a consonant-vowel-consonant, double the final consonant and add "-er".
 - Big => Bigger
 - Hot => Hotter
 - Wet => Wetter
 - Thin => Thinner
- If the adjective ends in a consonant + "-y", change "-y" to "-i", then add "-er".
 - Silly => Sillier
 - Lucky => Luckier
 - Happy => Happier
 - Lazy => Lazier



Mono-syllable Adjectives in Comparatives



- If the adjective ends in "-e", only add "-r".
 - O Large => Larger
 - Brave => Braver
 - Nice => Nicer
- And generally, we add "-er" when none of the situations above exists.
 - O Long => Longer
 - Fast => Faster
 - O Short => Shorter
 - Tall => Taller

Mono-syllable Adjectives in Superlatives



- If the adjective ends in a consonant-vowel-consonant, double the final consonant and add "-est".
 - Big => Biggest
 - Hot => Hottest
 - O Wet => Wettest
- If the adjective ends with a consonant + "-y", change "-y" to "-i", then add "-est".
 - Dry => Driest
 - Happy => Happiest
 - Silly => Silliest



Mono-syllable Adjectives in Superlatives



- If the adjective ends in "-e", add "-st".
 - O Large => Largest
 - Nice => Nicest
 - Brave => Bravest
- And generally, we add "-est" when none of the situations above exists.
 - O Short => Shortest
 - O Tall => Tallest
 - Small => Smallest
